## **Transport for London Notice**

## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

THE A5 GLA ROAD (EDGWARE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

- Transport for London in consultation with the City of Westminster hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable resurfacing works to take place at A5 Edgware Road.
   The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
  - (1) entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Boscobel Street between its junctions with Edgware Road and Venables Street;
    - (2) entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Frampton Street between its junctions with Edgware Road and Hatton Street;
      (3) entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Orchardson Street

between its junctions with Edgware Road and Lyons Place. Local Access to be maintained during the closures.

The Order will be effective every night between the 4th November 2024 and the 16th November 2024 from 8.00 PM to 6.00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes:
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Edgware Road and Penfold Street to normal route of travel.
