ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A5 GLA ROAD (EDGWARE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London in consultation with the City of Westminster hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable water main valve repair works to take place at A5 Edgware Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping in a north westerly direction on Edgware Road between its junctions with Kendal Street/George Street and Connaught Street/Upper Berkley Street;
 - (2) entering, exiting or proceeding on Kendal Street between its junctions with Edgware Road and Connaught Street, local access to be maintained.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 8.00 PM on the 1st November 2024 until 11.59 PM on the 3rd November 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Bayswater Road, Hyde Park Corner, Baywater Road, Lancaster Terrace, Sussex Gardens, Edgware Road, Harrow Road and Edgware Road to normal route of travel.
