### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14**

#### **TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – CORMONT ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable works including a crane operation to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Cormont Road which lies between the south-western kerb-line of Calais Street and the north-western kerb-line of Brief Street.
2. Alternative routes would be available via (a) Knatchbull Road and Calais Street and vice versa; and (b) Calais Street, Lothian Road, Akerman Road, Burton Road and Brief Street.
3. The road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order would come into force on 7th January 2019 and continue for a maximum duration of 6 weeks (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. It is anticipated that the Order would only have effect for about 2 weeks but if the works cannot be completed during that time, then the Order may continue for the maximum period of 6 weeks.
