### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

#### **TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VENN STREET**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable works to provide a new water supply to be carried out, Lambeth Borough Council intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering or waiting in that length of Venn Street which lies between Clapham High Street and No. 63 Venn Street.

2. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of traffic signs.

3. An alternative route would be available for affected vehicles via Clapham High Street, Stonhouse Street and Bromell's Road and the one-way system in Venn Street would be temporarily suspended to allow access for certain vehicles that are excepted from the ban in certain circumstances, such as emergency services vehicles.

4. The Order would come into force on 7th January 2019 and would continue for 1 month, or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect between 7th and 11th January 2019, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order would also have effect on subsequent dates.
