**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14  
TEMPORARY REMOVAL OF A PARKING PLACE AND BAN  
ON PARKING AND WAITING (INDICATED BY DOUBLE  
YELLOW LINES) IN SOMERLEYTON ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable re-development works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily remove the shared-use residents'/business/pay & display parking place which lies on the south-west side of Somerleyton Road from a point 9.6 metres south-east of Coldharbour Lane to a point 36 metres south-east of Coldharbour lane and install double yellow lines (this would have the effect of banning parking and waiting by vehicles at any time) in this length of Somerleyton Road instead.
2. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
3. The Order would come into force on 4th February 2019 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 18 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
