ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE JONATHAN STREET

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable water main connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Jonathan Street which lies between Tyers Street and a point 10 metres west of Tyers Street.
2. Alternative routes would be available for vehicles via (i) Tyers Street, Black Prince Road and Vauxhall Walk; and (ii) Vauxhall Walk, Glasshouse Walk and Tyers Street.
3. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The order would come into force on 7th May 2019 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect from 7th May for 4 days, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out on those dates the order would also have effect on subsequent dates within the maximum duration.
