### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

### **TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS ST GOTHARD ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable water main repair works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, have made an order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering or waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading and unloading a vehicle) in that length of St Gothard Road which lies between Beeton Way and the party wall of Nos. 80 and 82 St Gothard Road.
2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via Carnac Street, Clive Road, Hamilton Road, Gipsy Road, Rommany Road and St Louis Road and vice versa.
3. The bans will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The order will come into force on 30th April 2019 and will continue for a maximum duration of 2 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect from 30th April for 4 days but if the works cannot be completed or carried out on those dates, the order will also have effect on subsequent dates within the maximum duration of 2 months.
