Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Lewisham (Algernon Road, Mount Pleasant Road and Southbrook Road)

(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2019

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of Thames Water works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

1. (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in:- Algernon Road, SE13 between Marsala Road and Nos.166/168 Algernon Road; Mount Pleasant Road, SE12 between Fordyce Road and Nos.82/84 Mount Pleasant Road; and Southbrook Road, SE13 between Manor Lane and Wantage Road.

(2) The alternative routes for vehicular traffic affected by the closures are via:- Marsala Road and Ellerdale Street; Fordyce Road, George Lane and Aldworth Grove; and Manor Lane, Micheldever Road and Wantage Road respectively.

2. Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.

3. The order comes into force on the 1st May 2019 to remain in force for up to 3 months.

4. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.

(Note: works are expected to last between 5 to 8 days per site)
