Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Lewisham (Various Roads) (Blackheath race for Life) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2019

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and section 287 of the Highways Act 1980 to facilitate the holding of the 2019 Cancer Research "Race for Life" Event. The effects of the order are indicated below.

- 1.** (1) Road closures, prohibiting any vehicle from entering or proceeding, as events necessitate, in some or all of Duke Humphrey Road, Goffers Road, Hare and Billet Road, Long Pond Road, Mounts Pond Road east of Granville Park, Prince Charles Road, Talbot Place and Tranquil Vale between Royal Parade and Hare and Billet Road. (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected are via Shooters Hill Road (A2) and neighbouring local roads.
- 2.** No waiting at any time for any purpose including loading/unloading in Duke Humphrey Road, Goffers Road, Hare and Billet Road, Lee Road, Lee Terrace, Mounts Pond Road (east of its junction with Granville Park) Prince Charles Road, Prince of Wales Road, South Row, Talbot Place or Tranquil Vale (between Royal Parade and Hare and Billet Road)
- 3.** No right turn into Mounts Pond Road from Aberdeen Terrace, Eliot Vale, Granville Park or The Orchard.
- 4.** Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the event, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
- 5.** The order comes into force on the 30th June 2019 to remain in force for that day only. The restrictions and prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
