

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
STREATHAM COMMON SOUTH - TEMPORARY ROAD
CLOSURE, ONE-WAY SYSTEM AND BAN ON PARKING,
WAITING AND LOADING IN CONNECTION WITH THE
EUROPEAN ELECTIONS 2019

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order, the effect of which will be to temporarily:-

- (a) impose a one-way system in that length of Streatham Common South which lies between Copley Park and Covington Way in a south-westerly direction (towards Streatham High Road) (an alternative route for vehicles will be available via Copley Park, Baldry Gardens and Covington Way);
- (b) ban vehicles from waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading a vehicle) in that length of Streatham Common South which lies on the north-west side between Copley Park and Covington Way;
- (c) ban vehicles from entering or waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading a vehicle) in that length of:-
 - (i) Streatham Common South which lies between Covington Way and its junction with The Rookery;
 - (ii) The Rookery, so much as is public highway;
- (d) ban vehicles proceeding in Covington Way from turning right into Streatham Common South;
- (e) ban vehicles proceeding in Copley Park from turning right into Streatham Common South.

2. The one-way system, road closure, banned turns and waiting and loading restrictions are necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public caused by an increase in traffic in the vicinity as a result of the safe transit and unloading of ballot boxes for the European elections.

3. The one-way system, road closure, banned turns and waiting and loading restrictions will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 23rd May 2019 and will continue in force for a maximum duration of 2 days. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect from approximately 2 p.m. on Thursday 23rd May 2019 until approximately 6 a.m. on Friday 24th May 2019.
