

## **PROPOSAL TO ALTER THE SEN PROVISION AT DEPTFORD GREEN SCHOOL**

Notice is given in accordance with Section 19 (1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 and the School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013/3110 that Lewisham Council intends to alter the SEN provision at Deptford Green School (Edward Street, London SE14 6AN) from a Resource Base catering for students with a primary need of Dyslexia, to a Resource Base catering for students with a primary need of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD). The anticipated implementation date of this prescribed alteration is October 2019.
