### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – FERNDALE ROAD FOR BRIDGE INSPECTION WORKS**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable detailed bridge inspection works to be carried out to the railway bridges over Ferndale Road, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Ferndale Road which lies between Pulross Road and a point 61 metres north-east of the party wall of No. 226 Ferndale Road and Nos. 1 to 6 Trinity Court, Ferndale Road, whenever indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via (i) Bedford Road, Lendal Terrace, Clapham High Street, Landor Road, Hargwyne Street and Pulross Road; and (ii) Pulross Road, Hargwyne Street, Landor Road and Bedford Road.

3. The order will come into force on 17th July 2019 and will continue for a maximum duration of 1 month or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the order will only have effect between 10 pm and 6 am on 17th and 18th July 2019, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed on those dates the order will also have effect on subsequent dates and times.
