

**LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**  
**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – FLAXMAN ROAD FOR**  
**BRIDGE INSPECTION WORKS**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable detailed bridge inspection works to be carried out to the railway bridge over Flaxman Road, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Flaxman Road which lies between Coldharbour Lane and a point 15 metres north of Coldharbour Lane (measured on the west side).
2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Coldharbour Lane and Pomfret Road and vice versa.
3. Whenever the ban referred to in paragraph 1 above applies the Order that imposes the one-way working in Flaxman Road between Coldharbour Lane and Pomfret Road would be suspended in so far as that Order bans vehicles proceeding in that length of Flaxman Road from travelling in a direction other than towards Pomfret Road.
4. The ban and suspension would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
5. The order would come into force on 25th June 2019 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the order would only have effect between 11 pm and 6 am on 25th and 26th June 2019, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed on those dates the order would also have effect on subsequent dates and times.
