ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – LOWER MARSH

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable works involving the operation of a crane to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily :-

- (a) ban vehicles from entering that length of Lower Marsh which lies between Baylis Road and Lancelot Street (alternative routes for vehicles would be available via (i) Baylis Road, Waterloo Road, York Road, Addington Street and Westminster Bridge Road; and (ii) Baylis Road, Westminster Bridge Road, Kennington Road, Hercules Road, Lambeth Road, Lambeth Palace Road and Westminster Bridge Road);
- (b) suspend the one-way traffic system in the length of Lower Marsh which lies between Baylis Road and Lancelot Street, so as to permit access and egress for vehicles as far as the works allow.

2. The above road closure and suspension would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing or covering of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. The Order would come into force on 14th July 2019 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 1 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner.
