### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

#### **TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – LOWER MARSH**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable works involving the operation of a crane to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily :-

(a) ban vehicles from entering that length of Lower Marsh which lies between Baylis Road and Lancelot Street (alternative routes for vehicles will be available via (i) Baylis Road, Waterloo Road, York Road, Addington Street and Westminster Bridge Road; and (ii) Baylis Road, Westminster Bridge Road, Kennington Road, Hercules Road, Lambeth Road, Lambeth Palace Road and Westminster Bridge Road);

(b) suspend the one-way traffic system in the length of Lower Marsh which lies between Baylis Road and Lancelot Street, so as to permit access and egress for vehicles as far as the works allow.

2. The above road closure and suspension will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing or covering of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. The Order will come into force on 14th July 2019 and it will continue for a maximum duration of 1 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner.
