

**LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14**  
**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF WOODFIELD AVENUE**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable works to be carried out to complete road safety and public realm improvements at the junction of Woodfield Avenue and Mount Ephraim Lane, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Woodfield Avenue which lies between the eastern kerb-lines of Garrad's Road and Abbotswold Road and a point 40 metres north-east of those kerb-lines.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via (a) Garrad's Road, Tooting Bec Gardens and Streatham High Road for north-eastbound traffic; and (b) Streatham High Road, Ambleside Avenue and Garrad's Road for south-westbound traffic.

3. The restrictions will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 29th June 2019 and continue for a maximum duration of 2 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect at weekends for approximately 2 weeks but if the works cannot be carried out or completed at those times then the Order may have effect on subsequent days within the maximum duration of 2 months.
