Notice of Application for a New Premises Licence

Anyone wishing to oppose the application must give notice in writing to Licensing Authority, London Borough of Lewisham, Holbeach Office, 9 Holbeach road, London SE6 4TW within 28 days of the date of this notice, specifying the grounds of opposition. The application can also be viewed at the above address during office hours by appointment.

It is an offence knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application, the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for the offence is £5000. Persons objecting to the grant of licences must be prepared to attend in person at a hearing before a committee of the Council. NOTE: Your objection will form part of the committee report and forwarded to the applicant. Please let us know if you have a valid reason for your personal details to be removed.

This notice remains in force from and including the day after the giving of this notice to the licensing authority, namely 18th June, 2019, for 28 consecutive days.
