

**LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**  
**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - HINTON ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable bridge repair works to be carried out to the railway bridges over Hinton Road, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Hinton Road which lies between Coldharbour Lane and Wellfit Street (approximately 130 metres).

2. Alternative routes would be available for vehicles via (i) Coldharbour Lane, Herne Hill Road and Wanless Road and vice versa; and (ii) Coldharbour Lane, Railton Road, Rymer Street, Dulwich Road, Norwood Road and Milkwood Road.

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 25th July 2019 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only be in force between 10 pm on 25th July and 6 am on 26th July but if the works cannot be completed during that time the Order would also have effect on subsequent days.
