**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 16A
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN
CONNECTION WITH THE REPARATIONS MARCH 2019**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, with the agreement of Transport for London and Westminster City Council, have made an Order in connection with the Reparations March that is to take place on Thursday 1st August 2019.

2. The general effect of the Order will be to temporarily ban vehicles:-

(a) from entering, proceeding, stopping, parking or waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading a vehicle) in the roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice;

(b) proceeding in Acre Lane in the London Borough of Lambeth from turning left into Brixton Road.

3. Alternative routes will be available for vehicles affected by the bans described above, via adjacent streets as indicated by traffic signs.

4. The bans will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs or as directed by a police constable in uniform. It is anticipated that the Order will only be in force between 10 am and 8 pm on Thursday 1st August 2019, but if it is deemed necessary in the interests of public safety, the Order may also have effect at other times on that day.
