

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE GLENEAGLE ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable sewer cleaning works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Gleneagle Road which lies between the party wall of Nos. 3 and 5 Gleneagle Road and the party wall of Nos. 31 and 35 Gleneagle Road.
2. An alternative route would be available for affected vehicles via Ambleside Avenue, Babington Road and Conyers Road and vice versa.
3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The order would come into force on 11th September 2019 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier.
