ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – HERNE HILL ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable bridge repair works to be carried out to the railway bridge over Herne Hill Road, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Herne Hill Road which lies between Padfield Road and Wanless Road.
2. Alternative routes will be available for vehicles via Coldharbour Lane and Denmark Hill and vice versa.
3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order will come into force on 19th August 2019 and will continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only be in force between 10 pm on 19th August and 6 am on 20th August but if the works cannot be completed during that time the Order will also have effect on subsequent days.
