

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE LEIGHAM AVENUE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable Thames Water to carry out water main monitoring and maintenance works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Leigham Avenue which lies between Conifer Gardens and No. 44 Leigham Avenue.
2. Whenever the ban referred to in paragraph 1 above applies the one-way system in Leigham Avenue between Woodleigh Gardens and Conifer Gardens would be suspended.
3. The above road closure and suspension would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing and covering of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via (a) Streatham High Road, Gracefield Gardens and Conifer Gardens; and (b) Streatham High Road, Drewstead Road, Sternhold Avenue, Streatham Hill, Leigham Court Road, Culverhouse Gardens, Gracefield Gardens and Conifer Gardens.
5. The Order would come into force on 24th August 2019 and would continue for a maximum duration of 13 months (to allow for contingences) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect at certain times between August 2019 and July 2020.
