ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – MEPHAM STREET

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable bridge inspection works to be carried out to the railway bridge over Mepham Street, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering Mepham Street.
2. An alternative route for vehicles affected by the closure would be available via York Road, Addington Street, Westminster Bridge Road, Baylis Road and Waterloo Road.
3. The road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order would come into force on 16th September 2019 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only be in force between 16th and 20th September but if the works cannot be completed during that time the Order would also have effect on subsequent days.
