

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – WESTERN ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable telecommunication connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Western Road which lies between Gresham Road and a point 20 metres north-east of Gresham Road.

2. Whenever the ban referred to in paragraph 1 above applies the one-way system in Western Road will be suspended.

3. The road closure and suspension will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing and the covering of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via (i) Gresham Road, Wiltshire Road, Fyfield Road and St James Crescent; and (ii) Gresham Road, Coldharbour Lane, Barrington Road and St James Crescent.

5. The Order will come into force on 31st August 2019 and will continue in force for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingences) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works will be carried out between 31st August and 1st September 2019 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed in that time then the Order may also have effect on subsequent days up to the maximum period of 1 month.
