ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF WOODFIELD AVENUE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable new gas main connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from:-

- (a) entering that length of Woodfield Avenue which lies between Drewstead Road and Mount Ephraim Lane;
- (b) waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading a vehicle) in that length of Woodfield Avenue which lies between Drewstead Road and No. 20 Woodfield Avenue.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via (a) Mount Ephraim Road, Streatham High Road and Drewstead Road; and (b) Drewstead Road, the unnamed road that links Drewstead Road with Sternhold Avenue, including the bridge over the railway situated to the west of Streatham Hill Station, Sternhold Avenue, Streatham High Road and Mount Ephraim Road.

3. The restrictions will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 12th August 2019 and continue for a maximum duration of 2 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect from the 12th August for 6 weeks but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days within the maximum duration of 2 months.
