Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Lewisham (Various Roads SE4) (Crofton Park)

(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2019

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of highway regeneration works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

- 1.** Road closure and no parking/waiting in (i) Brockley Road, between Eddystone Road and Dalrymple Road; (ii) Brockley Grove, between Brockley Road and Brockley Hall Road; (iii) Hazeldon Road and Holdenby Road, between Brockley Road and Buckthorne Road; (iv) Marnock Road and Merritt Road, between Brockley Road and Brockley Grove; (v) Darfield Road, between Brockley Grove and Lindal Road; and (vi) Beecroft Road, between Brockley Road and Beecroft Lane.
- 2.** The alternative routes for vehicular traffic affected are via local neighbouring roads.
- 3.** One way working in (i) Merritt Road – eastbound only; and (ii) Darfield Road – westbound only.
- 4.** Suspension of existing one way working in both Marnock Road and Beecroft Road
- 5.** Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
- 6.** The order comes into force on the 5th August 2019 to remain in force for up to 12 months. (Note: The closures will generally only be for a few days within the 12 month period to allow resurfacing works to be completed.)
- 7.** The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
