ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY "AT ANY TIME" PARKING, WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS BLOOM GROVE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable Virgin Media cable repair works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from parking and waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle) at any time in that length of Bloom Grove which lies:-

- (a) on the north and north-west side, between the western kerb-line of the vehicular entrance to the rear of Nos. 380 to 388 Norwood Road and the common boundary of Nos. 15 and 16 Bloom Grove;
- (b) on the south and south-east side, between the common boundary of Nos. 6 and 7 Bloom Grove and the party wall of Nos. 9 and 10 Bloom Grove.

2. The ban on parking and waiting by vehicles would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. The Order would come into force on 30th September 2019 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner.
