

## **LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**

### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 16A CAR FREE DAY - TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS ALDEBERT TERRACE, FENTIMAN ROAD, HURST STREET, LEWIN ROAD, ST STEPHEN'S TERRACE AND TRINITY RISE FOR SPECIAL EVENTS**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the general effect of which will be on Sunday 22nd September 2019, to temporarily ban vehicles from entering and waiting (including waiting for loading/unloading purposes in:-

- (a) Aldebert Terrace, between No. 11 Aldebert Terrace and No. 29 Aldebert Terrace;
- (b) Fentiman Road, between Carroun Road and its junction with Palfrey Place and Trigon Road;
- (c) Hurst Street, the whole length;
- (d) Lewin Road, the whole length;
- (e) St Stephen's Terrace, between Aldebert Terrace and No. 8 St Stephen's Terrace;
- (f) Trinity Rise, between Norwood Road and Brockwell Park Gardens.

2. The Order is necessary to enable social events to take place in the roads referred to in paragraph 1 above in connection with Car Free Day and it will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. Alternative routes will be available for vehicles affected by the bans described above, via adjacent streets.
