

**LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14**  
**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES – CAREW STREET**  
**AND SOUTHWELL ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable electricity connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth has made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from:-

- (a) entering or proceeding in a northerly or north-easterly direction in Carew Street; and
- (b) entering that length of Southwell Road which lies between Northlands Street and the north-eastern boundary of No. 100 Southwell Road (the north-eastern extremity of the road).

2. Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the closure of Carew Street will be available via Lilford Road, Coldharbour Lane and Denmark Road. There is no alternative route in relation to the closure of Southwell Road as that road is a no through route, however access to and egress from properties in the closed part of Southwell Road will be maintained, when the works allow it.

3. The road closures described above will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 30th September 2019 and it will continue for a maximum duration of 5 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner.
