

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – MAULEVERER ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable new sewer main connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Mauleverer Road which lies between Lyham Road and No. 23 Mauleverer Road.

2. The above road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Lyham Road, Strathleven Road and Margate Road and vice versa.

4. The Order would come into force on 23rd September 2019 and would continue in force for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingences) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be carried out between 23rd September and 11th October 2019 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed in that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days up to the maximum period of 2 months.
