

LICENSING ACT 2003

Application for Variation of Premises Licence

Clapham Leisure Limited has applied to the London Borough of Lambeth for the variation of a Premises Licence in respect of the following premises: Old Town Tavern, 29 North Street, London SW4 0HJ which would authorise the following licensable activities: No licensing hours or activities are being requested. We are looking to extend the trading area to the basement and would like to mirror licensable activities and conditions of the ground floor in the basement area. To be used as an additional area for eating or drinking or for private hire. It will also have an area for private dining'.

The record of this application may be inspected during normal office hours by an appointment at the Licensing Section, London Borough of Lambeth, 3rd Floor, Civic Centre, 6 Brixton Hill, London SW2 1EG, or via the licensing authority's website, at www.lambeth.gov.uk/licensing.

A responsible authority or any other person may make representation to the licensing authority in respect of this application. Representations must be made in writing, either by post to the above address, or by email to licensing@lambeth.gov.uk and must be received no later than 3rd October 2019.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with a licensing application, and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for that offence shall not exceed level 5 on the standard scale (£5,000).
