

TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF PEDESTRIAN AND VEHICULAR TRAFFIC FOR FILMING IN WALCOT SQUARE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable filming to take place in Walcot Square the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles and pedestrians from entering:-

- (a) the north-east arm of Walcot Square;
- (b) the western arm of Walcot Square; and
- (c) that length of the southern arm of Walcot Square which lies between Bishop's Terrace and St Mary's Walk.

2. Alternative routes would be available for affected vehicles and pedestrians via St Mary's Walk, St Mary's Gardens and Bishop's Terrace and vice versa.

(In practice it is anticipated that filming would be intermittent, so pedestrian access to and from premises in the above lengths of Walcot Square would be maintained outside filming).

3. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing and covering of the appropriate traffic signs and they would not apply to any vehicle or person connected with the filming.

4. The Order would come in to force on 6th October 2019 and continue for a maximum duration of 3 days or until the filming is completed whichever is the sooner.
