Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Lewisham (Various Roads) (Resurfacing) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order (No.2) 2019

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of resurfacing works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

- 1.** (i) Road closure and no parking/waiting in any road or length of road specified in schedule 1 below. (ii) The alternative routes for vehicular traffic affected are via local neighbouring roads where practicable.
- 2.** Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
- 3.** The order comes into force on the 30th day of September 2019 to remain in force until 31st March 2020. (Note: The majority of roads in schedule 1 below will be closed for two or three days at most, or nights in a few cases, the duration of which being relative to its length. Residents in all roads will receive written notification and an indication of the times and duration of any works)
- 4.** The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
