Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Lewisham (Various Roads) (UK Power Networks) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2019

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council intend to make this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of UK Power Networks works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order will be as indicated below.

- 1.** (1) Road closures, one way working and no parking/waiting in all or part of:- Jevington Way; Senlac Road; Heather Road; Ballamore Road; Railway Children Walk Footpath; Reigate Road; Northover; Whitefoot Terrace; Longhill Road; Brookehowse Road; Broadmead; King Alfred Avenue; Firhill Road; Grangemill Road; Winsford Road to Broadmead Footpath; Winsford Road; Selworthy Road; Lescombe Road; Priestfield Road; Queenswood Road; Dacres Road; London Road to Dacres Road Footpath; and Sydenham Park. (2) The alternative routes for vehicular traffic affected by the closures will be via local neighbouring roads.
- 2.** One way working and no parking/waiting in all or part of:- Bellingham Road and Randlesdown Road.
- 3.** No parking/waiting in:- Burnt Ash Hill, between Ashwater Road and Kingsand Road; Baring Road, between Bramdean Crescent and Coopers Lane; Verdant Lane, between Whitefoot Lane and Lincombe Road; Whitefoot Lane between Whitefoot Terrace and Dowerderry Road; Bellingham Road, between Birkhall Road and Bromley Road; Randlesdown Road, between Bromley Road and Gramsci way; Perry Hill, between Nos.189/191 and 202/204; Perry Rise, between Nos.41/43 and 57/59; and Mayow Road, between Nos.55/57 and 61/63.
- 4.** Suspension of the current one way working in Reigate road and Pendragon Road.
- 5.** Exemption will be provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
- 6.** The order is intended to come into force on the 1st October 2019 to remain in force for up to 6 months.
- 7.** The prohibitions will apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
