ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A2 GLA ROAD (NEW CROSS ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2019

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to allow a crane operation to take place on New Cross Road.
- The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping in the Loading and Disabled Persons Vehicle bay outside Nos. 495 to 501 New Cross Road.

The Order will be effective between on 13th October 2019 and 20th October 2019 every Sunday 9:30 AM to 3:00 PM or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibition will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
