Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Lewisham (Morley Road and Caterham Road, SE13)

(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

- 1.** (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in (i) Morley Road between Nos. 17/19 and 23/25 Morley Road, and (ii) Caterham Road between Lockmead Road and Nos.11/13 Caterham Road. (2) The alternative routes for vehicular traffic affected by the closure of Morley Road are via Slaithwaite Road and Lingards Road, and vice versa, and that for Caterham Road shall be via Lockmead Road and Boyne Road, and vice versa.
- 2.** Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
- 3.** The order comes into force on the 3rd February 2020 to remain in force for up to 3 months.
- 4.** The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
