

## **LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**

### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – ALASKA STREET**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable bridge inspection, maintenance and repair works to be carried out over the railway bridge over Alaska Street, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering Alaska Street.
2. An alternative route for vehicles affected by the closure will be available via Waterloo Road, Exton Street and Cornwall Road and vice versa.
3. The road closure will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order will come into force on 22nd February 2020 and it will continue for a maximum duration of 12 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will be in force between 22nd and 24th February (inclusive), 1st and 4th May (inclusive), 9th and 11th May (inclusive), 6th and 8th June (inclusive), 26th and 28th September (inclusive) and 28th and 30th November 2020 (inclusive), between 11 pm and 5 am on each occasion. If the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time, the Order will also have effect on subsequent dates and times.
