ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY BANNED RIGHT TURN FROM BRIXTON
HILL INTO BRIXTON WATER LANE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable water main works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth with the agreement of Transport for London, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles proceeding in a northerly direction in Brixton Hill (towards Brixton Road) from turning right into Brixton Water Lane.
2. The ban on vehicles turning right into Brixton Water Lane from Brixton Hill, would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
3. An alternative route would be available for vehicles affected by the banned turn via Brixton Hill, Brixton Road, Stockwell Road, Stockwell Park Walk, Brixton Road, Brixton Hill and turn left into Brixton Water Lane.
4. The Order would come into force on 7th March 2020 and would continue for a maximum duration of 3 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect between 7th and 22nd March but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time, the Order would have effect on subsequent dates.
