THE COUNCIL OF THE LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM hereby gives **NOTICE** that on 14th February 2020 it made an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the Stopping Up of: -

The area of land at the convergence point of Amersham Vale and Edward Street (illustrated on the proposed Stopping Up Order plan).

THE ORDER is to allow for the construction of residential dwellings in accordance with:-

- a) the planning consent granted by the London Borough of Lewisham and issued 16th July 2018 under registration no. DC/15/095027 for the construction of residential blocks ranging between 1 and 5 storeys in height comprising 120 residential flats, maisonettes and houses, together with the provision of refuse and cycle storage and associated landscaping at the land of the former Deptford Green School, Amersham Vale, SE14;
- b) the drawings submitted as part of the application for the above consent.

COPIES OF THE ORDER AND RELEVANT PLANS MAY BE INSPECTED during office hours (Monday - Friday between 9am - 5pm) at Laurence House, 1 Catford Road, London SE6 4RU for 28 days commencing on **Friday 14th February 2020**.

THE ORDER COMES INTO FORCE on the date of first publication of this notice.

ANY PERSON AGGRIEVED by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within 42 days of the 14th February 2020 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
