

Transport for London Notice

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A2 GLA ROAD (BLACKHEATH ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF GREENWICH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2020

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable cycling facility improvement works to take place at A2 Blackheath Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping:
 - (1) in the parking and disabled person's vehicles bays outside Nos.68-70 Blackheath Road, Nos.78-80 Blackheath Road and No.77a Blackheath Road;
 - (2) in the loading and disabled person's vehicles bays outside Nos.69-73 Blackheath Road;
 - (3) outside No.75 Blackheath Road;
 - (4) outside Nos.37-45 Blackheath Road.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 7:00 PM on 24th February 2020 until 5:00 AM on 28th February 2020 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
