**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 16A
TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF PEDESTRIAN AND
VEHICULAR TRAFFIC FOR FILMING IN GAMBETTA
STREET AND ROBERTSON STREET**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable filming to take place in Gambetta Street and Robertson Street, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth with the agreement of the Council of the London Borough of Wandsworth, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles and pedestrians from entering:-

(a) Gambetta Street, the whole length; and

(b) that length of Robertson Street which lies between Montefiore Street and Silverthorne Road.

2. Alternative routes for vehicles and pedestrians affected by the road closures described above would be available via Silverthorne Road, Thackeray Street and Montefiore Street and vice versa.

(In practice it is anticipated that pedestrian access to and from premises in the above roads would be maintained throughout filming)

3. The bans would only have effect at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs and they would not apply to any vehicle or person connected with the filming.

4. The Order would come into force on 20th April 2020 for a maximum duration of 2 days. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect between 12.30 pm on 20th April and 00.30 am on 21st April 2020 but if the filming cannot be carried out or completed during that time, the Order may have effect at other times on those dates.
