

## LICENSING ACT 2003

### Application for Grant of Premises Licence

James Fitzgerald on behalf of The Greater London Authority has applied to the London Borough of Lambeth for the grant of a Premises Licence, in respect of the following premises:

Hungerford Car Park, South Bank, London, SE1 8XX which would authorise the following licensable activities:

Films, Recorded Music, Live Music, things of a similar description and supply of alcohol on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday between 12:00-23:00, between 12th June 2020-12th July 2020 (reserve days until 15th July in case of disruption).

A responsible authority or any other person may make representation to the licensing authority in respect of this application. Representations must be made in writing, either by post to the above address, or by email to [licensing@lambeth.gov.uk](mailto:licensing@lambeth.gov.uk) and must be received no later than 09/04/2020.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with a licensing application, and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for that offence shall not exceed level 5 on the standard scale (£5,000).
