ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – NEW PARK ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable works to be carried out to introduce road humps, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of New Park Road which lies between its junction with Streatham Place and Atkins Road (the South Circular) and its junction with Thornton Road and Thornton Avenue.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via (a) Streatham Place, Streatham Hill, Telford Avenue and Thornton Avenue and vice versa; and (b) Thornton Road, Kings Avenue and Atkins Road and (c) Atkins Road, Poynders Road, Kings Avenue and Thornton Road.

3. The road closure described above will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs and it will apply in sections of New Park Road as the works progress along the road, allowing vehicular access to and from properties whenever possible.

4. The Order will come into force on 16th March 2020 and it will continue for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingences) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
