### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

#### **TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – NEW PARK ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable works to be carried out to introduce road humps, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of New Park Road which lies between its junction with Streatham Place and Atkins Road (the South Circular) and its junction with Thornton Road.
2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via (a) Streatham Place, Streatham Hill and Telford Avenue and vice versa; and (b) Thornton Road, Kings Avenue and Atkins Road and (c) Atkins Road, Poynders Road and Thornton Road.
3. The road closure described above would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs and it would apply in sections of New Park Road as the works progress along the road, allowing vehicular access to and from properties whenever possible.
4. The Order would come into force on 16th March 2020 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingences) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
