Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Lewisham (Bartram Road, SE4)

(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of Thames Water works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

- 1.** (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in Bartram Road between numbers 20 and 30 Bartram Road. (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected are via either Brockley Road, Eddystone Road and Buckthorne Road and vice versa, or Brockley Road, Courtrai Road and Buckthorne Road and vice versa.
- 2.** Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
- 3.** The order comes into force on the 8th June 2020 to remain in force for up to 2 months.

(Note: Works are expected to be carried out between 8th and 12th June 2020)

- 4.** The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
