Notice of Variation to a Premises Licence

NOTICE IS GIVEN THAT an application has been made to Lewisham Council (the Licensing Authority) for a variation to the Premises Licence by Patrick Ryan and Joseph Ryan in respect of The White Hart, 184 New Cross Road, London, SE14 5AA.

The details of the application are as follows:

To add sale of alcohol for consumption off the premises between the hours of 07:00 – 03:00 Monday – Sunday. To remove the following condition from Annex 2 “There shall be no sale of alcohol for consumption off the premises”. To remove the following condition on Annex 2 “Patrons permitted to temporarily leave and then re-enter the premises, e.g. to smoke, shall not be permitted to take drinks or glass containers with them”.

Details of the application may be inspected by appointment only at Crime, Enforcement & Regulation Service, Licensing Authority, Holbeach Office, 9 Holbeach Road, SE6 4TW.

Any interested party or responsible authority may make representations in respect of the application, which must be submitted, in writing, to the above address within 28 days of the date below.

This notice remains in force from and including the day after the giving of this notice to the licensing authority, namely 23/04/2020, for 28 consecutive days.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with an application. The maximum fine on summary conviction is £5,000.
