ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – FAIRVIEW PLACE, DEEPDENE GARDENS AND REDLANDS WAY

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable new telecommunication works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from:-

- (a) entering that length of Fairview Place which lies between Upper Tulse Hill and Brockham Drive (alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Upper Tulse Hill, Maplestead Road and Holmewood Gardens and vice versa);
- (b) entering that length of Deepdene Gardens which lies between Fairview Place and the western arm of Redlands Way (alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Fairview Place, Holmewood Gardens and the southern arm of Deepdene Gardens and vice versa);
- (c) entering or exiting the western arm of Redlands Way at its junction with Deepdene Gardens (alternative routes for vehicles would be available via Fairview Place, Holmewood Gardens, the southern arm of Deepdene Gardens and the eastern arm of Redlands Way and vice versa).

2. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. The Order would come into force on 22nd June 2020 and would continue in force for a maximum duration of 6 months (to allow for contingences) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
