ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - GLENELDON MEWS

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable water main connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Gleneldon Mews which lies between No. 6 Gleneldon Mews and No. 10 Gleneldon Mews.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via (i) Gleneldon Road, Bournevale Road and Stanthorpe Road; and (ii) Stanthorpe Road, Gleneagle Road, Ambleside Avenue, Garrad's Road, Becmead Avenue, Streatham High Road and Gleneldon Road.

3. The road closure will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 6th July 2020 and it will continue for a maximum duration of 5 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works will be carried out between 6th and 9th July 2020 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed in that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days up to the maximum period of 5 months.
