

## **LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**

### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – NEW PARK ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable water main connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily:-

(a) ban vehicles from entering that length of New Park Road which lies between No. 262 New Park Road and No. 19 New Park Road;

(b) ban vehicles from entering or exiting Lyham Road at its junction with New Park Road.

2. The above road closure will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via (a) Brixton Hill, Dumbarton Road, Lyham Road, Chale Road and Kingswood Road and vice versa.

4. The Order will come into force on 7th July 2020 and will continue in force for a maximum duration of 5 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works will be carried out between 7th and 11th July 2020, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed in that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days up to the maximum period of 5 months.
