

# **LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM**

## **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

### **The Lewisham (Various Roads) (Thames Water) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2020**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lewisham Council made this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of Thames water repair works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

- 1.** (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in (i) Darfield Road, SE4 between Brockley Road and Lindal Road, and (ii) Pepys Road, SE14 between Sherwin Road and Ommaney Road. (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibitions are, in the case of Darfield Road, via Brockley Road, Merritt Road and Brockley Grove and vice versa, and in the case of Pepys Road, via Musgrove Road, Jerningham Road and Ommaney Road, and vice versa.
- 2.** (1) Road closure for northbound traffic and no parking/waiting in Lee Park, SE3 between Lee Terrace and Lock Chase. (2) The alternative route for traffic affected by the prohibition is via Lee Park, Lee High Road and Lee Road.
- 3.** (1) Road closure for southbound traffic and no parking/waiting in Breakspears Road, SE4 between Harefield Road and Glensdale Road. (2) The alternative route for traffic affected by the prohibition is via Harefield Road, Wickham Road and Glensdale Road.
- 4.** Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
- 5.** The order comes into force on the 15th June 2020 to remain in force for up to 3 months.
- 6.** The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
